

CATCHMENT AREA

Scalby School has a catchment area. Students who live in this area attend Scalby School through residential qualification. As a general guide, places are provided for those who live in the areas served by the following Primary Schools: Lindhead, Hackness, Wykeham, Brompton and Sawdon, Snainton and parts of the catchment areas of Newby, Barrowcliff and Northstead Schools. The Scarborough area is outlined on the map below. However, many parents who live outside these areas request Scalby School as a first preference and their children are offered places. Application to register a preference must be made to the local Education Offices. If your child attends a local Primary School and is in his/her final year, the Education Office will contact you and offer you a choice. If you are moving into the area you will need to contact the Education Office on Valley Bridge Parade, Scarborough.

In 2005 the numbers living in the catchment area are relatively low so we anticipate that there will be some 60-70 places available for students living outside the school's normal area.
