Re: Immersion Day – It's a Knockout

As part of our commitment to extending the range of experiences available to our students, Year 10 students will be given the opportunity to take part in 'It's a Knockout' where, if they want to win, they will have to work as a 'Team'.

This activity will take place as part of our Immersion Day programme on Friday 26th of June at school and over at the school field. This is a fun filled day which will in part reward year 10 for all their hard work this year.

As you may be aware we have been running several competitions to promote improved attendance in school, for example the 'Every Day Counts' half termly competition, the '25 day Challenge' and 'Boys vs Girls'.

There are 42 school days between the start of the Summer Term and Friday 19th June, a week before the immersion day. Students will need to have 95% attendance during this period in order to take part in the activities on the 26th June. This allows for only 3 days absence. Obviously, genuine medical conditions/appointments will be taken into consideration when the final selection is made.

Students will be given the opportunity to choose their own teams and raise money for the Children's Ward at Scarborough Hospital. More information will follow nearer the event.

I would also like to take this opportunity to introduce two other attendance related activities that take place in Year 11. The Xscape trip which happens in the spring and the Year 11 prom, which is after the GCSE examinations. These also have a 95% attendance qualification. It goes without saying that term time holidays would prevent students from taking part in any of these activities.
