Dear Parent/Carer

I write to inform you that a Year 10 students tested positive for Covid-19 on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October. This means that all of our Year 10 students must self-isolate for 14 days from 6<sup>th</sup> October, as instructed by the Department of Education.

After checking with the student's family, I can confirm that the students did not make contact with other students in any other year group.

Apart from Year 10 students, all students in other year groups should continue to come to school as usual. The school is still operating within the framework of the rigorous risk assessment, which we prepared in advance of the school opening in September. We also operate an enhanced cleaning schedule throughout the whole school day.

Thank you for ensuring that your child has a face mask when they come to school. Some students who are using disposable facemasks are reporting that they can break, so it is worthwhile supplying your child with two disposable facemasks if they are using these.

Should you or any other member of your household develop COVID-19 symptoms it is important that your child self-isolates until the results of the COVID-19 test is known.
