Dear Parent / Carer,

Following the completion of the asymptomatic testing programme on the return to school and college, it is vital that students keep testing at home throughout the Easter holidays and into the summer term. Students should:

- test twice a week at home from now on (all those who are able to)
- report results <u>online</u>, via the NHS website as positive, negative or void. This information is critical in helping to understand the prevalence of the virus across the country
- continue to test twice weekly over the Easter holidays on a Monday morning and Thursday morning
- inform school of any positive or void tests either by phone 01723 362301 or by email to <u>ContactTrace@scalbyschool.org.uk</u>. If a student has a positive test result, they will need to stay home and self-isolate. If the result of the test is unclear (void) they will need to do another one. Following a positive test at home, a confirmatory PCR test should be booked through the local testing centre at William Street Coach Park.
- test before returning to school or college for the summer term, either the night before, or morning of, the first day back, to find and isolate any positive cases
