Your child is now being set assessment preparation / revision tasks online via Google Classroom or MS Teams (Computing & Business). Tasks will be set in Google Classrooms and MS Teams (Computing & Business) today. Please be reassured that our staff will adjust their GCSE assessment plans over the coming days to ensure that students are not disadvantaged by this period of self-isolation. The examining bodies provide us with flexibility to take into account these types of situations. Live Learning support via Microsoft Teams will begin on Friday.

Teachers will deliver online 'Live Learning Support' sessions in line with your child's timetable. These sessions will be a chance for your child to receive advice and guidance from their teachers and ask any questions about how to complete the assessment preparation tasks set on Google Classroom and on MS Teams (Computing and Business). Some subjects may also ask students to undertake mini assessments during these sessions. Students will be able to complete tasks whilst their teacher is present. Students will be able to move from lesson to lesson following their timetable, via Microsoft Teams. Students should return to school on **Tuesday 4th May following the bank holiday.**

Students can log in to each of these live sessions for as long as they are able. For instance, if your child needs to share a device with another family member to complete their work, they may need to take it in turns to access their timetabled lessons. To access Live Learning Support sessions, your child will need to log-in to Microsoft Teams via their Student Portal, click on 'Teams' and then select the relevant class.
