Dear Parent / Carer,

Many thanks to those families who have been undertaking lateral flow testing with your son/daughter this half term, it is vital that students keep testing at home throughout the half term holidays and into the Summer 2 term to continue to limit the spread and protect our community. Students should:

- continue to test twice weekly over the half-term holidays on a Monday morning and Thursday morning.
- inform school of any positive or void tests either by phone 01723 362301 or by email to <u>ContactTrace@scalbyschool.org.uk</u>. If a student has a positive test result, they will need to stay home and self-isolate. If the result of the test is unclear (void), they will need to do another one. Following a positive test at home, a confirmatory PCR test should be booked through the local testing centre at William Street Coach Park.
- test before returning to school, either the night before, or morning of, Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2021, to find and isolate any positive cases
