## **Remote Learning 7b1**

## Thursday 15th July 2021 - Friday 23rd July 2021

On Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> July teachers will set work via google classroom. From Friday 16<sup>th</sup> July teachers will deliver online 'Live Learning Support' sessions in line with your child's timetable via MS Teams. These sessions will be a chance for your child to receive advice and guidance from their teachers and ask any questions about how to complete the assessment preparation tasks set on Google Classroom and on MS Teams (Computing and Business). Some subjects may also ask students to undertake mini assessments during these sessions. Students will be able to complete tasks whilst their teacher is present. Students will be able to move from lesson to lesson following their timetable, via Microsoft Teams. Due to the timing of this self-isolation students should return to school at the start of the new academic year in September.

Students can log in to each of these live sessions for as long as they are able. For instance, if your child needs to share a device with another family member to complete their work, they may need to take it in turns to access their timetabled lessons. To access Live Learning Support sessions, your child will need to log-in to Microsoft Teams via their Student Portal, click on 'Teams' and then select the relevant class.
