Dear Parents/ Carers,

Provisional Plan to Return to Scalby:

After the Easter holidays the plan will be to bring Year 7 back to the Scalby site. To support them with the transition back to the main school they will be based together in the new Portacabin village and will remain with the same members of staff currently working with them at the Scalby Campus. We are currently planning a comprehensive transition process to ensure all students are well supported with the move. We are also in the process of looking at the timetable that will be in place on our return, where possible the additional five periods will be dedicated to the creative curriculum areas.

Additional Curriculum:

As you will be aware there are a small number of subjects that are not currently part of the Year 7 curriculum. Our Curriculum Leaders are carefully planning the subject curriculums for when the Year 7's return, to support with closing any potential gaps in learning. In the meantime, we have created an 'Additional Curriculum Support' space on Google Classrooms. Teachers have posted a range of learning resources and materials that students can optionally complete at home if they would like to start introducing themselves to Food Technology, Product Design, Drama, Music and Computing.




